Local MP to be Master Wanger?

Shirenewton, Monmouthshire: The Welsh Welly Wanging Open is pleased to announce that the local MP, David Davies, has confirmed that he will attend the inaugural Welsh Welly Wanging Open Championship will be held on Saturday 2nd June 2012 at Shirenewton (Trenwydd Gelli Farch Sir Fynwy) in Monmouthshire.

David Davis has been the Member of Parliament for Monmouth since 2005. A keen sportsman, he has fought in several charity boxing matches as 'The Tory Tornado' and in February 2011, he was unveiled as the next president of the Welsh Amateur Boxing Association. As such, he is expected to be a highly competitive wanger and may even be crowned 'Master Wanger' if he wins – which is the highly coveted (?) title awarded to the winner of the male adults category. The female adults category winner is crowned 'Mistress Wanger'.

The Championship, sponsored by Countrywide Farmers, is open to all comers and will feature three age groups (over 16 years, under 16 years and under 13 years) with a male and female category in each age group. The winners of each category will receive a trophy and Countrywide voucher.

The Championship starts at 2:00pm with final wanging at 4:45pm and prize giving shortly afterwards. These hours coincide with the Shirenewton Village fete which will be co-located.
